Application by MD 111-Germany to the Europa Forum 2025 in Dublin

Topic:

Proposal to increase the prize money for the Lions European Music Competition Thomas Kutí (LEMC) at the European Forums.

Explanation:

Over the past three decades, the Lions Music Competition has developed in many Europa Forum member countries as a permanent activity to promote talented young musicians.

The “Long Range Planning Committee Europe” discusses a resolution for the Europa Forum in Bordeaux to implement the existing “Rules of Procedure” of both the “Bert Mason Young Ambassador Award” and the Music Competition as organic activities in the Europa Forums in the long term.

This also includes the appropriate endowment of the Music Competition with prize money that corresponds to a European competition level.

At the 2016 Europa Forum in Sofia, the prize money for the European level was increased for the last time.

In order to maintain the standard of a European Music Competition, MD 111-Germany is applying to the Europa Forum to increase the prize money from a total of 10,000 euros to 15,000 euros, effective from the Europa Forum 2026 in Karlsruhe.

Financial Impact:

The costs of the prize money at the Europa Forum are to be included in the Europa Forum budget. This will increase from a total of 10,000 euros to 15,000 euros.
