STATUS REPORT EUROPEAN WORKING GROUP LIFEABILITY

The Group was created at the Europa Forum in Bordeaux at the end of October 2024. It took some time to get in touch with all and every European D or MD in order to check their availability to take part in the group. At the end 15 districts decided to step in:

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The Group met 3 times (i) 19th of March immediately before the Mediterranean conference;(ii) 13th of June;(III) 20th of June; in order to know each other and understand what are the problems that need to be faced. The German representative (Ulf Grundmann) raised the question of the name Lifebility which is very well known in Italy, with a strong brand equity, but not elsewhere. Moreover the word “Lifebility” doesn’t mean anything in the various languages of the Group, which makes even more difficult to build up a brand equity now in countries different from Italy.

Thereby the Group agrees to keep discussing in order to find a suitable name at least in the countries that do not like the name Lifebility and write down a “status report” for the time being. At the same time also the system of the rules of functioning will be examined.
